## [KHP Corporate Bingo Bowl](#)

Kids Help Phone is Canada's only toll-free, bilingual, phone and web counseling, referral and information service for children and youth. It is open 24 hours a day, 365 days a year and responded to over 2 millions requests last year. Calls range from questions about drug and alcohol abuse, teen pregnancy, friends and family, suicide and more.

In 2007 Kids Help Phone needed to shut down its services such as 'Ask a Counselor' weekly because of the number of requests and the lack of funds. Measures have been taken to ensure that all kids have a chance to speak with someone when help is needed.

As part of the Canadian Fivepin Bowlers' Association, the W5PBA has been involved in raising funds for the past 13 years. Last year through a variety of fundraisers the C5PBA raised over \$120,000 which translated into roughly 40,000 more phone calls being answered.

On Saturday, April 18th we will be holding our first Annual Corporate Bingo Bowl from 7:00pm until 9:30pm at Mosienko Lanes. We are inviting businesses to send in teams of 5 for \$100. Individual spots are also available at \$20 per person. Food will be provided along with a silent auction and 50/50 draws taking place. Teams must be registered by Thursday April 9th. ## 3rd Annual Golf Tournament

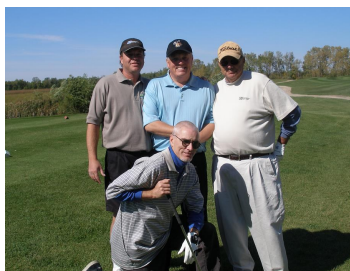
This years golf tournament will be taking place at La Verendrye Golf Course in La Broquerie, MB on Saturday, July 18th.
