The 78th Annual City Championships and Winnipeg Open Team Trials was held on Saturday, January 31st and Sunday, February 1st at St.Vital and Rossmere lanes. 16 women and 27 men played for a chance to represent Winnipeg at the M5PBA Provincial Open in Brandon on April 9-11. The top 3 men and women make up the single representatives, along with the next 3 men and women, along with the singles make up the men's and ladies teams.

Spots 7-9 make up the mixed teams. Singles will be a 10 game qualifying round with the top 5 making the stepladder at Provincials, while the teams will play a 12 game round robin, with the top two teams playing in the stepladder final on Saturday afternoon.
