2009 marks the 100th year of five pin bowling in Canada. First discovered by Tommy Ryan in 1909 in Toronto, the sport has grown over the years to become the most widely played recreational sport throughout Canada and was recently named the 4th greatest Canadian invention of all time!

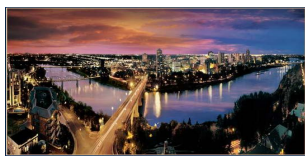

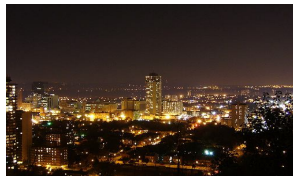
