YOUTH CHALLENGE – RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Competitors must be at **least 13 years of age and not more than 18 years of age** as of December 31, 2011.
2. Competitors **MUST be members of the C5PBA for the current year.**
3. Bowlers may only enter once. There will be a **maximum of 50 entries.**
4. No smoking will be allowed within the bowling centre. The consumption of alcohol by bowlers, coaches or spectators is prohibited at all levels of this event.
5. Entry Fee is \$40.00 and must be included with the entry form. Entry fee includes all lineage charges. All cheques and money orders must be made payable to the Winnipeg 5-Pin Bowlers' Association.
6. **Entry deadline is MIDNIGHT on SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 6, 2011.**
7. The **top seven males and top seven females along with the next highest bowler** (male or female) at the conclusion of the 5 game qualifying tournament will advance to represent Winnipeg at the Provincial Youth Challenge Championship at Evans Lanes in Neepawa on Saturday, December 3, 2011.
8. Ties for 1st place, 5th place or for the final qualifying positions, as well as for the position of alternate, will be broken by a one game playoff to be bowled immediately upon completion of the tournament.
9. The bowlers finishing in 1st through 5th places will make up the men's and ladies' teams at the Provincial Championships. The bowlers finishing in 6th and 7th place, plus the 15th qualifier will make up the mixed team.
10. **BE ON TIME.** Latecomers will start in the frame in which they arrive, providing the leadoff bowler on their lane has not commenced the following frame.
11. Personal bowling balls will be allowed at the discretion of the proprietor and **are subject to random inspection by the tournament officials of the W5PBA.** In the case of delays in returning personal bowling balls, the bowler must continue with house balls (i.e. no delay of game). **All balls must bear initials or other identifying marks – balls not complying with this rule will be considered house balls and may not be moved from lane to lane.**
12. Any exceptions to the above rules **OR** decisions on matters not covered in the above rules will be made at the discretion of the Winnipeg 5-Pin Bowlers' Association Tournament Committee and/or the Board of Directors of the W5PBA. Bowlers retain the right to appeal all rulings to the Manitoba 5-Pin Bowlers' Association.
13. The W5PBA will supply shirts to all bowlers competing at the Provincial Finals. **Bowlers will be required to provide their own black slacks to be worn during the competition. Uniforms must be worn for all championship events, exhibitions and banquets.** The shirts will become the property of the bowler upon conclusion of the event. **Bowlers in violation of the dress code at the Provincials may be disqualified from the tournament and subject to suspension or a fine from M5PBA or W5PBA.**
14. At the Provincial Finals, the top 3 men and the top 3 ladies will qualify to represent Manitoba at the 2012 Youth Challenge Nationals to be held in Winnipeg, Manitoba from March 22 – 25, 2012.
15. The M5PBA will be assessing all bowlers and coaches representing Manitoba at the National Championships the amount of **\$100.00.**
